



### Manitoba Off Road Vehicle Inspection

A visual inspection of each recreational vehicle unit to be insured for **physical damage** is required **prior** to binding coverage. A copy of the applicant's expiring policy (with similar coverage); or a copy of a bill of sale indicating the purchase of a new or used Recreational Vehicle in the last ten (10) days (dealer demonstrator excluded) must be presented to waive inspection. Bills of sale from private deals are NOT accepted.
